

The Institute for Supply Management Alaska (ISM-Alaska) Scholarship Fund

Purpose:

To provide financial assistance for tuition and other education expenses to students pursuing a program of study in logistics at the College of Business and Public Policy at the University of Alaska Anchorage.

Qualifications:

Recipient must be a degree-seeking with a declared logistics major for the Associate Degree in Logistics and Supply Chain Operation, or the Global Supply Chain major in the Business Administration program in the College of Business and Public Policy at the University of Alaska Anchorage.

Recipient must submit a short essay about his or her interest/commitment in purchasing/supply management.

Recipient must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better.

Preference will be given to students with academic merit and who display a demonstrated interest in Professional Purchasing and Supply Chain Management. Preference will be given to students who have not previously been awarded a baccalaureate or associate degree.

Preference will be given to Alaska residents.

Selection Process:

Recipients shall be chosen by the UAA CBPP Standing Scholarship Selection Committee; committee to include a faculty representative from the logistics department. Once the selection committee selects finalists, representatives from the ISM Alaska board of directors may review the finalists' applications and make non-binding recommendations.

Award Amount:

Two awards to be made each year: One \$500 award to a student enrolled in Associates Degree in Logistics and Supply Chain Operation, and one \$500 award to a student enrolled in the Global Supply Chain major in the Business Administration program. If there is not a qualified applicant in each program, both awards may be awarded to students in the same program.
